TOWN OF JACKSON PLANNING BOARD MEETING May 3, 2016

MINUTES

A **motion** was made by Tully, seconded by Gordon to approve the April 5th regular meeting minutes as written. Motion carried in favor, 4-0 with Mahoney abstaining.

REAFIELD FARM

The owners of Reafield Farm are considering subdividing a triangular portion of parcel #223.-1-22-1 (18.7 acres) starting along Wood Lane and extending to parcel #223.-1-12 (3.2 acres). This portion of land would be used to build a driveway for the 3.2 acre parcel which was recently purchased by Thane Rea and his wife, Dawn where they plan to build a residence.

While the Board was comfortable with the subdivision sketch plan, they discussed alternative options for the Reas such as establishing a right-of-way or easement. After meeting with the surveyor, the Reas will determine what their best option will be.

SOLAR WORKSHOPS

The Board discussed the April 19th Solar workshop that five town officials attended. The discussion led to a variety of questions. A **motion** was made by Mahoney, seconded by Tully to recommend that the Town Board pass a six-month moratorium on approving building permits for all commercial, for profit solar arrays while the Town Board studies the need for site plan review law. Motion carried 5-0.

SITE PLAN REVIEW

The Board discussed elements of site plan review. The Clerk will obtain a copy of White Creek's site plan review law as well as contact resident (and planning attorney), Leah Everhart about similar towns that might have an effect site plan review law that Jackson could review.
