### **RESOLUTION NO. 72-15**

**RESOLVED**, to approve the September 2, 2015 Town Board meeting minutes as written.

**2015 & 2016 Budgets** – The board discussed at length the current 2015 budget hoping to identify line items where cuts to the budget could be made. Supt. Carney needs to determine now which roads will be paved or chip-sealed next year, so that he can identify how many culverts need to be replaced this fall. No final decisions were made.

**RESOLVED**, that the Town of Jackson will offer an insurance buyout option to full-time employees in the amount of \$4,000 annually starting in 2016 to be payable with the last payroll of each quarter.

**RESOLUTION NO. 75-15**

Eliminate the health insurance buyout option

Resolution by Councilman Nolan

Seconded by Councilman Rouse

And defeated 2-3, with Brown, Rea and Rich voting against

**RESOLVED**, that the Town of Jackson will abolish the health insurance buyout option for full-time employees effective December 31, 2015.
