7:40 PM PUBLIC HEARING #2 for SITE PLAN REVIEW LAW

Supervisor Skellie opened the second of two public hearings on a proposed site plan review law at 7:40 pm. Planning Board Chair Noel Hanf gave an overview of the proposed law. Once again, the majority of the residents present were in favor of having a site plan review law. The Town also received an email of support from Geoffrey Ovington and Bonnie Hoag. Ed Gadarowski said, *Site plan review is a common sense approach and gives the Town an extra tool in their tool bag when development occurs. Use it as a positive, not a negative.*

Although site plan review was the focus of the meeting, several residents commented about Brand New Beginnings Youth Center (BNBYC) which led the conversation away from site plan review. The Board directed the Town Clerk to obtain contact information of someone at NYS Office of Children and Family Services who residents/taxpayers could contact to express their views about BNBYC's project. The information will be available on the Town's website. Public Hearing closed at 8:35 pm.
