WASHINGTON COUNTY TRANSFER STATION

Laura Chadwick, Director of Washington County Real Property Tax Services was present to share a map of the Transfer Station located in Jackson. The County has a contract to sell the proposed lot of 5.45 acres to Earth Waste and Metal (EW&M) who has been leasing all of the county Transfer Stations for the last five years. Since the parcel also contains the County Highway building and fuel facilities, the Transfer Station needs to be subdivided from the lot. A proposed easement to EW&M for ingress and egress over the existing access has been established.

The application, SEQR and Agency Designation forms will be submitted for the next meeting with Washington County later in June. The Planning Board will need to schedule an additional June meeting in order to complete this project prior to the closing date.
