Local Law No. 1 of the year 19 75

A local law in relation to the maximum exemption allowable for the alternative

veterans exemption from real property taxation.

of JACKSON as follows:

Section 1. The purpose of this law is to reduce the maximum veterans exemption allowable pursuant to section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. (a) Qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of fifteen percent of the assessed value of such property; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of six thousand dollars or the product of six thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Town of Jackson.

(b) In addition to the exemption provided by paragraph (a) of this subdivision, where the veteran served in a combat theatre or combat zone of operations, as documented by the award of a United States campaign ribbon or service medal, qualifying residential real property shall also be exempt from taxation to the extent of ten percent of the assessed value of such property; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of four thousand dollars or the product of four thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Town of Jackson.

(c) In addition to the exemptions provided by paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subdivision, where the veteran received a compensation rating from the United States veteran's administration because of a service connected disability, qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of the product of the assessed value of such property multiplied by fifty percent of the veteran's disability rating; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed the lesser of twenty thousand dollars or the product of twenty thousand dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Town of Jackson.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the City of having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of ^{§ 36} _{§ 37} of the Municipal Home Rule Law and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the ^{special} _{general} election held on 19 became operative.

(County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

6. I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. of 197 of the County of, State of New York, having been submitted to the Electors at the General Election of November, 19, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of Section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and of a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
