

LOCAL LAW NO. 1

TOWN OF JACKSON, WASHINGTON COUNTY, NEW YORK

A local law to provide for the retention of elected assessors in the Town of Jackson, Washington County, New York.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Jackson as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1556 of the Real Property Tax Law the three offices of assessor of the Town of Jackson, shall continue and shall be elective as provided by the law in effect immediately prior to the effective date of said Section 1556.

SECTION 2. This local law shall be submitted for the approval of the electors of the Town of Jackson at a special election to be held in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law except that such special election shall be held not later than July 1, 1971.

SECTION 3. This local law shall become effective on the 20th day after approval thereof by the electors of the Town of Jackson at a special election specified in Section 2 hereof and after filing a publication required by said Municipal Home Rule Law.
