as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Authority; Title.

This chapter is enacted pursuant to the authority of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the Town of Jackson.

Section 2 Definitions.

- A. The words and terms used in this Chapter shall have the same meanings as such words and terms are used in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law, unless otherwise provided herein or the context requires a different meaning.
- B. As used herein, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

CHIEF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER - The County Sheriff of the County of Washington.

CLERK - The Town Clerk of the Town of Jackson.

TOWN - The Town of Jackson

Section 3

License Required.

Games of chance may be conducted in the Town by an authorized organization, after obtaining a license therefore from the Clerk, in accordance with the provisions, requirements and limitations of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law, the rules and regulations of the of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board, this local law and any amendments thereto.

Section 4

Frequency; Conduct on Sundays and Additional Restrictions.

- A. Games may be conducted under a license as frequently as permitted under General Municipal Law Section 195-b.
- B. The conduct of games of chance on Sundays is authorized, and licenses issued by the Town Clerk should specifically so provide, except as is otherwise provided in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law.
- C. There shall be no additional restrictions in addition to those set forth in Section one hundred eighty nine of the General Municipal Law and any amendments thereto.

Section 5

Enforcement.

The chief law enforcement officer shall exercise control over and supervision of all games of chance conducted under an appropriately issued license. Such officer shall have all those powers and duties set forth in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law.

Section 6

Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State if it shall be approved by a majority of the electors entitled to vote thereon at the general election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 1994.
