SOLAR LAW UPDATE

the law based on former issues with Jackson Solar 1, LLC, as well as to review any recent solar regulations adopted by other municipalities. Board member Ammaturo offered to meet with Chair Donahue and Clerk Dixson to begin working on the draft.

JACKSON SOLAR 1, LLC GLARE CONCERN

A neighboring property of the Jackson Solar 1, LLC project has reached out to Chair Donahue regarding a glare coming from the solar panels into her home. Barton and Loguidice has been notified of this concern and are working with both the property owner and Millcreek Renewables to rectify the issue. Board members questioned Assessor Christine Matatt on the rate solar projects are taxed at. Christine will provide the Board with additional information on tax rates for commercial solar facilities following an upcoming training.
